The Deux-Rives Youth Hostel is located in the heart of the public garden of the same name. This park is so much more than just a place where people go for a Sunday stroll; it is, to our knowledge, the only public garden in the world straddling a national border. Its walkway stretches over the Rhine, linking France and Germany in a fraternal embrace, the very symbol of the European Union, peace and friendly relations.

From the Hostel, it is easy to get to Strasbourg town centre by tram for some sightseeing, admiring the famous cathedral with its flamboyant Gothic style, the picturesque quarter of La Petite France, or the imperial district of Neustadt, all recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Alternatively, why not cross over the Rhine and discover the charming German town of Kehl.

**GETTING TO : Auberge de Jeunesse des Deux Rives**

**BY TRAIN:** STRASBOURG station or KEHL station (Germany)

**From Strasbourg station:**

**Bus line 2**, towards « Jardin des Deux Rives », leaving the stop « Gare Centrale » every 10 mins from 8 am to 8 pm, every 20-30 mins after 8 pm, last bus at 11.45 pm. Get off at the terminus, and the Hostel is a five minute walk;

or **Tram line D**, going to either « Port du Rhin » or « Kehl Rathaus », departing from Gare Centrale every 5-15 mins, last tram at 10.52 pm. Get off at Port du Rhin and walk 10 mins to the Hostel.

**From Kehl station (Germany):**

**Tram line D** in the direction of « Parc des Poteries »; leaves every 13-16 mins until 7.29 pm, and every 20-30 mins after that, with a last departure at 2 minutes past midnight. Get off at Port du Rhin and the Hostel is a 10 min walk.

Ticket machines in bus & tram stations ◊ *Tip: do not throw the tickets away, they are rechargeable!*

**BY PLANE:** airport of Strasbourg-Entzheim – there is direct train link from the airport to Strasbourg station up to 4 times an hour, which takes about 8 mins: <https://www.strasbourg.aeroport.fr/FR/Passagers/Acces/Navette-train.html>

There is also the Karlsruhe-Baden Airport (in Germany) or alternatively the EuroAirport Basel-Mulhouse-Freiburg (in France/Switzerland).

**AVAILABILITY:** the « Strasbourg 2019 » Gathering will host 260 participants.

**RECEPTION:** since the Youth Hostel is well served by public transport (tram + bus) a shuttle service will not be provided.

**Accommodation at the Strasbourg Deux Rives Youth Hostel:**

Rooms are simple with 3-5 beds (sometimes bunks). Bathrooms/WCs are shared (some rooms have ensuite facilities). Bed linen is provided but please bring a towel.

As the number of rooms available is limited, and to ensure as many people as possible can be accommodated, couples will not necessarily be allocated a 3-person room to themselves.

◇ **Please kindly note that priority will be given to participants over those wishing to accompany them**

**CATERING:** all meals including breakfast will be provided by the Youth Hostel on a self- service basis. Vegetarians will be catered for.

**GENERAL RULES AND CANCELLATIONS**

The Gathering is open to practitioners who are up-to-date with their subscriptions, individually or collectively through their affiliated associations. The Gathering is also open to practitioners of other styles, upon invitation by the Committee Board (limited to 5 places) in the framework of the access policy approved by the General Assembly of 8 November 1997 at Houlgate.

At its Gatherings, the Amicale is happy to welcome accompanying non-practitioners subject to availability, and once the requests of practitioners have been taken into account.

When registering for the Gathering, accompanying persons should indicate their status and will be placed on a waiting list. Places still free after 31 August will then be made available.

**By registering, I accept in full the following points:**

- Registrations shall be deemed valid upon receipt of full payment which must be made within 15 days of registration.
- I will not claim any right to images or films taken/recorded during the Gathering.
- If I take photos and/or make films during the Gathering, I agree to provide a copy to the Amicale for its archives.
- I accept the following cancellation conditions:
  - . All cancellations must be made in writing both to the Bureau of the Amicale and to the organisers of the Gathering.
  - . No sums will be withheld if the cancellation takes place before the application deadline.
  - . After this date, sums may be deducted according to when the cancellation takes place in relation to the beginning of the Gathering.

**In the event of duly justified Force Majeure, the following fixed amount shall be deducted:**

- Zero euros 30 days before the first day of the Gathering;
- Fifteen euros (€ 15) between 29 and 10 days before;
- Thirty euros (€ 30) between 9 and 5 days before;
- Fifty euros (€ 50) between 4 days before and the day itself.

**In the event of non-justified Force Majeure, the following proportional amount shall be deducted:**

- 30% from the day after the end of registrations to 20 days before the first day of the Gathering;
- 50% between 19 and 10 days before;
- 100% between 9 days before and the day itself.

**However, no sums shall be deducted if cancellation is due to health reason and where such an activity would be counter-indicated (medical certificate obligatory).**

A minimum delay of 10 full days must be respected when informing those on the waiting list if their request has been successful.

**NB:** the Bureau of the Amicale will study each cancellation request on a case-by-case basis, before deciding whether to deduct sums, and after consultation with the organisers. The Bureau of the Amicale remains sole judge as to whether Force Majeure may be applied.
